We don't know about you, but Shmoop loves the realism of this, and the way in which Paulsen levels with his readers. He doesn't try to sugarcoat anything because he's writing for kids . One more note: a lot of readers have actually complained to Paulsen about the ending of the book-or at least about the fact that Brian gets rescued before winter sets in and the going really gets tough.
